Eligibility: Must be a City/State/National Govt agency or department. Partner organizations can nominate government agencies by submitting an application on their behalf.

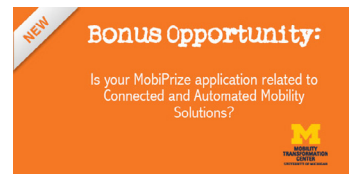

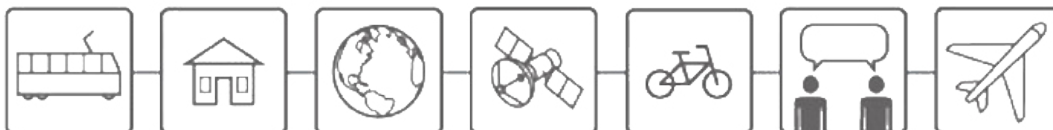
